



## 'Where My Wellies Take Me!'



We use the Maths Rose Hub to form our planning for mathematics.

Our focus this term is Fractions, Shape, Data and Number. Any opportunity to practise online, and play games that involve number work would be good additional learning. Where possible, encourage your children to count every day and try to vary the way you begin and end your counting- i.e. one day it might be twos, then tens then beginning on 12 for example, rather than 1. Have competitions to make the learning fun and try to encourage your child to work on the Maths targets in their reading records.

During our Literacy we shall be writing fantasy stories and Animal Poems. As part of our writing, we will be learning about tenses, plurals, suffixes, alliteration and similes.

To help at home you could read and write stories together and look at poems about animals.

Your child will have a literacy target in their reading record to practise at home.





## For Science

For Science we are looking at seasonal changes and understanding the different types of weather.

We will finish off the topic by planning and performing a weather report.

**Geography:** We will be looking at becoming more familiar with the locality. To do this we will be learning how to read maps and understand the symbols and coordinates. We will then conduct our own surveys and analyse the results. We will finish by having a celebratory picnic on the field.

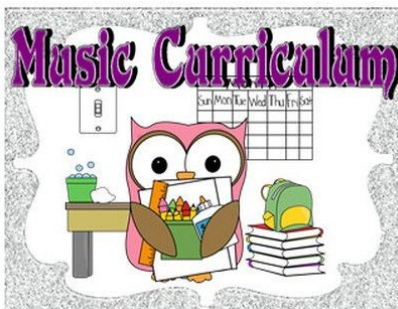
**RE:** We will be looking at Special places and why they are special. We will be looking at how different places are special to different religions.

This half-term Squirrels class will be starting with e-safety and then moving onto data handling. They will finish the topic with multi-media and get to produce their own weather report!
