## **Universal Infant Free School Meals**



Every infant child in Reception, Year 1 and 2 is entitled to have a free meal at school. The Government has made this decision because a good lunch makes an enormous difference to children's health, development and ability to learn. It is also important that children develop good healthy eating habits to combat the rising problem of childhood obesity. If you would like your child or children to receive a free meal at school, you must complete the application form overleaf and return it to your school office.

## **Pupil Premium**

You don't have to be in receipt of a benefit to take advantage of a free meal at school. They are available for all infant children. However, schools receive extra funding for children that come from families on low incomes. This is called Pupil Premium. This money is sent to schools by Central Government based on the numbers of pupils in the school who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). The Pupil Premium will be used specifically within school to help eligible children reach their full potential, both academically and socially.
